## The Client:

Located in San Diego County, Torrey Pines High School teaches more than 3,300 students in grades 9 to 12. The nationally funded Blue Ribbon Schools Program has honored Torrey Pines' commitment to educational excellence three times. Other organizations and media also have recognized the school's high standards and exemplary achievements in academia and sports.



### The Situation:

Vandalism and other general security concerns prompted school officials to start thinking about better ways to monitor the 40-acre Torrey Pines campus. The school does not have its own IT

department, so the solution needed to be one that regular staff could readily administer. School officials were looking for a video monitoring system that students and the wider community would support. Initial research indicated CCTV was too manpower intensive; a digital IP solution seemed a much easier option.

#### The Solution:

D3Data won the competitive bid to install an IP security solution for Torrey Pines High School. The software developer created a video surveillance system with the NETVM Unlimited software solution and 15 Axis 2120 network cameras, which were installed in various outdoor locations. 
#### Ease of Use:
